From Starbucks to Microsoft, Chihuly glass to Pike Place Market, Seattle is known as one of the hottest markets for young talent in the country. Currently in the midst of a huge building boom largely fueled by the tech sector, Seattle is also struggling to update its transportation system, live up to its hype as the "greenest" city in the U.S. and address equity issues through the first-in-the-nation for large cities

The famous (or infamous) "Seattle process" of slow, deliberative, community and political debate has both helped and hurt the region in the 11 years since the Minneapolis Regional and Saint Paul Area Chambers of Commerce visited the area for its InterCity Leadership Visit. So it is time to check back and see what's changed and what hasn't.

When last we left Seattle the region was planning its LINK LRT line connecting downtown to the Seattle-Tacoma Airport. Voters in the region approved a major expansion of the light rail system in 2008, and Sound Transit is now actively developing light rail extensions to the south, east and north. New streetcars are operating as well. The Alaskan Way Viaduct (major north south freeway adjacent to the waterfront) was slated for demolition to be replaced by a tunnel. Construction began in December 2013 but was halted a few weeks later and hasn't resumed.

In terms of innovation, Seattle is recognized globally for its tech sector and increasingly for its biotech and healthcare R&D which supported 100 start-ups last year. And, the Seattle economy is also benefitting from a certain football team that has been in the news recently.
