HIGHLAND LASSIES DAY May 6, 2015


- WHEREAS, the Highland Lassies women's golf league was formed at Hyland Greens Golf Course on the first Wednesday of May in 1964; and
- WHEREAS, the league started with 54 women from Annunciation Church who wanted to get out of the house, socialize and enjoy nature; and
- WHEREAS, in order to join Highland Lassies in those early days, members had to live in Bloomington and belong to Annunciation Church on West 54th Street and Lyndale Avenue South in Minneapolis; and
- WHEREAS, there were 54 women in that first league and there are currently 54 women in the league today; and
- WHEREAS, one-thousand women have participated in the Highland Lassies Golf League over the past fifty years; and
- WHEREAS, friendship and fellowship are the key reasons why this league has remained intact for fifty years; and
- WHEREAS, Lynn Gasterland and Sally Callahan are the longest-term members with 22 years of membership each; and
- WHEREAS, members of the Highland Lassies love the staff, beauty of the course, and the affordability of play at Hyland Greens; and
- WHEREAS, not one of the Highland Lassies has ever had a hole in one, no one has ever liked the water hazard on hole number 7, and slow play has been on the League's agenda since 1964.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Gene Winstead, Mayor of the City of Bloomington, Minnesota, do hereby declare the day of May 6, 2015, as
