## Description

It is requested that the City Council consider approving plans, specifications and schedule for the 2015-202 Pedestrian Crossing Improvement Project.

This project includes the installation of Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) systems along with associated pedestrian ramp improvements at three locations including American Blvd, Portland Ave and East Bush Lake Rd.

Staff applied for and has received federal funding from the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) in the amount of \$170,640 with a 10% local agency match of \$18,960 for a total project cost of \$189,600. Bloomington local funds will cover the local match amount with no special assessments proposed.

A map has been included showing the location of these improvements.
