

# Request for Council Action

Description

The City Council is requested to hear the resident appeal to amend the posted parking restrictions on 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

A resident request for a change in the posted parking restrictions on 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue was initially received in October 2014. At that time the procedure identified in the Public On-Street Parking Policy (enclosure for your reference) was initiated. The enclosed memo, “18<sup>th</sup> Avenue Parking Modification Request Process” provides a detailed description of the process, including the resident request and petition, first parking restriction option surveyed and resident responses, second parking restriction option surveyed and resident responses, and final letter to residents indicating no changes were approved based on the resident responses. It also includes a description of other actions taken in the area by Environmental Health and Bloomington Police Department, to try to address the issues and concerns identified in the initial request and resident comments.

The final step in the Process allows a resident to submit a written appeal of the decision and option to request that the issue be heard by the City Council at a Public Hearing. The resident that filed the initial request for parking restriction changes on 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue has submitted that appeal.

The resident appealing the results of the Process has indicated she will be in attendance at this Public Hearing and will have an opportunity to present her request to the Council. It is unknown at this time what specific change will be requested by the resident.

Any changes to parking restrictions will be posted and updated on the official “No parking Zones” map which is periodically presented for Council adoption.
