Dear Resident or Property Owner:

Thank you for your participation and responses regarding the proposed parking changes along 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

As identified in the Public On-Street Parking Policy (<http://bloomingtonmn.gov/cityhall/dept/pubworks/engineer/traffic/ordup/parkingpolicy.pdf>) a minimum of 50% of survey responses need to support the proposed change in order to move forward with implementation. Since the responses received with the November survey did not meet the minimum 50% in support, Staff is **NOT** moving forward with the proposed parking ordinance modification and the current parking ordinance will remain in place:

**“No Parking, This Block” along the east side of 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Park Road to E 89<sup>th</sup> Street**

Per the City’s on-street parking policy residents have 15 days upon receiving this letter to submit a written appeal regarding the outcome of the study. If no appeals are received the parking modification request will be considered completed and no changes will be made.
