Dear Resident or Property Owner:

You recently received a letter and resident survey detailing a petition received by the City asking it to consider restricting on-street parking along the west side of 18th Avenue between Park Road and E 89th Street and allow parking on the east side of 18th Avenue between Park Road and E 89th Street. Based on feedback received from the resident survey the proposed parking regulation change has been modified.

The following option is now being considered for comment:

Allow parking on both sides of 18th Avenue between Park Road and E 89th Street

If this change is approved parking on both sides of 18th Avenue would be allowed at any time, for up to 24 consecutive hours. Please provide comments regarding the proposed changes on the attached survey and return it in the enclosed, postage paid envelope. Please include your name and address on the bottom of the survey and return it by January 19, 2015.

Following review of the returned surveys, a final plan will be developed and you will be notified of the decision prior to implementation of any sign/parking modifications in the area. Please feel free to contact me with any questions.
