Description

A number of factors including a changing golf industry and unfavorable weather have diminished business and created an ongoing operating loss at Hyland Greens Golf and Learning Center. Staff have analyzed the current financial conditions at Hyland Greens and developed potential alternatives for the course's future.

At the City Council study meeting on June 8, Council directed staff to set up a public engagement process for several of the alternatives, including redevelopment of the property, conversion to a park and a hybrid approach that would incorporate a park-like amenity into a residential development. A key component of the public engagement process is creation of the Hyland Greens Task Force to study the golf course's future.

At the City Council meeting on July 27, staff will present an overview of the history of Hyland Greens and its current financial condition as well as potential alternatives for re-use of the site. Staff will also review revisions to the task force charge, composition and timeline based on Council's input at the July 6 meeting.

Requested Action

Review revisions to the Hyland Greens Task Force charge, composition and timeline and provide feedback.
