## Description

The City Council is requested to consider ordering the 2015-905 Pond Maintenance Project. This project includes dewatering, excavation and disposal of pond sediments and minor storm sewer maintenance at four ponds:

- Hyland Hills Pond North, 9900 Dakota Road
- Hyland Hills Pond South, 9900 Dakota Road
- St. Edward Pond, West 94th Street near Nesbitt Avenue South
- Kingsdale Pond, 9301 Collegeview Road

The ponds will be excavated to their original contours to restore the flood protection and water quality functions. Pond sediments were sampled for testing in early September, and pending results, the excavated sediment will either be landfilled (if the contamination levels exceed State thresholds), or composted/reused at the Contractor's option.

Residents living in the vicinity of these sites will be notified of the pending construction and, if necessary, informational meetings will be held. Construction is anticipated to begin in late December 2015.

Funding is available in the Storm Water Drainage Utility Budget under Fund 665545 and no assessments will be involved in the project. This project is expected to be approximately \$350,000.
