Requested Action

Staff recommends approval of the 2016 Striping Reconfiguration Program with the following striping configuration for each street segment:

**W 98th Street: Normandale Boulevard to Nesbitt Avenue**

- 2-Lane Configuration
- One drive lane in each direction, wide striped shoulders, dedicated turn lanes and modified medians

**Lyndale Avenue: W 106th Street to W 102nd Street**

- 3-Lane Configuration
- One drive lane in each direction, a center two-way dual left turn lane, and striped shoulders
