Proposal to use Poplar Bridge Elementary

Jesus Celebration Church has contacted the Building Reservations department with Bloomington Public Schools seeking a new meeting location for their Sunday morning services. They currently hold services at the Bloomington Hilton Hotel on 494 and France Ave.

The church has approximately 50-75 attendees. They would like to use Poplar Bridge Elementary school as their home site as it is geographically close to their current location. They would use the school on Sunday mornings from approximately 8 am to 12 noon.

Within the school, they propose to use the lunchroom as the service area and use a Teacher's Lounge and the Kids Safari classroom as programming spaces for youth. Square footage of these spaces follows. The gym is a space that might be needed in the future if the congregation grows.

Lunchroom: 40' x 60'

Kids Safari Room (#109): 23' x 35'

Teacher's Lounge (#8): 18' x 35'

Gym: 50' x 80'

Bloomington Schools currently has three small churches meeting in all three of the middle school buildings on Sunday mornings.
