BOY SCOUT TROOP 439 DAY

- WHEREAS*, Boy Scout Troop 439 was formed and Chartered at Christ the King Lutheran Church in Bloomington, MN on December 13, 1965; and
- WHEREAS*, Troop 439 began with 20 Scouts and 12 Adult Leaders; and
- WHEREAS*, there were 20 Scouts in the Troop when it began and there are over 50 Scouts in the Troop today; and
- WHEREAS*, in the 50 years of Troop 439, 65 young men have earned Scouting's highest rank of Eagle Scout, and
- WHEREAS*, Boy Scouts have been living and learning the 12 Points of the Scout Law, the Scout Oath, to Be Prepared, and Do a Good Turn Daily for fifty years; and
- WHEREAS*, Scouts have been performing a variety of community service projects over the last fifty years; and
- WHEREAS*, many Bloomington boys have participated in Troop 439's adventures and service to the community since 1965.
