Description

Attached is a proposed resolution to authorize the Port Authority to pay up to \$30,000 for security cameras and related infrastructure along Lindau Lane. The Mall of America works with the Bloomington Police Department to coordinate Police and security response on mall property, both inside and outside the mall. The Lindau Lane plaza and tunnel area is now partially occupied by MOA buildings with the completion of Phase 1C. Cameras and related infrastructure are needed to be installed to monitor and record video footage of the area in and around the Lindau tunnel. The MOA is best equipped to monitor and record this footage, as the BPD does not have staff and infrastructure to do so. The total project is estimated to cost between \$50,000 and \$60,000. Port Staff and the MOA have negotiated a cost share to complete the camera project, with the Port paying \$30,000 out of MOA TIF proceeds.

Funding for the project is available in the MOA 1-C TIF fund.

Requested Action

Pass a motion to approve the attached resolution approving up to \$30,000 for security cameras and related infrastructure along Lindau Lane near the Mall of America.
