Description

The City Council is requested to approve funding for construction testing services as part of the 2016-201 Normandale Boulevard (CSAH 34) Reconstruction Project. This project was ordered by City Council on November 3, 2014. The 2016-201 Normandale Boulevard (CSAH 34) Reconstruction project is a safety improvement project that includes the reconstruction of Normandale Boulevard from 94th Street to Nine Mile Creek. The construction testing services for approval will involve the necessary construction testing including organic removal, concrete and piezometers among other necessary tests along the corridor to aid in the reconstruction of the road widening, trail installation and retaining wall construction.

Engineering sent solicitations to five firms for the 2016-201 Construction Testing Services. Three quotations were received by the requested deadline. The selection was based on qualifications and experience, project personnel, project understanding and cost to value. Based on these criteria Braun Intertec Corp. is the preferred firm.

Testing costs will be paid through the 4130 account.

The contract for these services will be routed through the Legal department prior to final signatures by the City Attorney, City Manager and Consultant.

It is requested to approve the funding for construction testing services as part of the 2016-201 Normandale Boulevard (CSAH 34) Reconstruction Project in the amount of \$100,000 which includes \$84,980.00 as base contract plus a \$15,020.00 of contingency.
