

# Request for Council Action

Description

It is requested that the City Council consider approving plans and specifications for the 2016-101 PMP (Pavement Management Program) Street Improvement Project.

The 2016-101 PMP Project includes street reconstruction and utility maintenance of approximately 4.06 miles of roadway previously approved and ordered for construction by Council in late 2015. Two of the segments previously approved and ordered for construction will be brought to Council at a later date for plan and specification approval. These segments include Old Cedar Avenue, which will be part of the 2015-203 Old Cedar Avenue Bridge Trailhead and 2016-204 Old Cedar Avenue Trail Projects and also 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue, which will be part of the 2016-501 Bloomington Avenue Sanitary Sewer Project. Funding for the 2016-101 PMP Project is in accordance with the approved Pavement Management Program policy, budgeted utility maintenance funds, and assessments.

The 2016-103 – 301 W 90<sup>th</sup> St Hydrant Project will also be completed as part of the 2016-101 PMP Project. The 2016-103 project will be ordered and approved at Council separately and funded by the benefitting property owner.

The 2016-101 PMP Project also includes the construction of small sidewalk sections on the south side of American Boulevard between Portland Avenue and Chicago Avenue and also the east side of Chicago Avenue just north of American Boulevard. This project will also include subgrade and street corrections of two known frost heave areas on Garden Circle and Colorado Road. These items will be funded by available internal funds.

A map has been included showing these project locations, along with a listing of the PMP street sections.
