Description

The City Council is requested to approve the Grant Subaward Agreement pertaining to the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program Education (SNAP-Ed) Grant awarded to the City of Bloomington through its Public Health Division (BPH).

In its application for this Grant, BPH proposed the use of multiple coordinated approaches to obesity prevention in Bloomington and Richfield, targeting Latino children and families through childcare, schools and community settings. Further, the project proposed bridging Latino families with community partners to create an environment that increases access to healthy culturally-appropriate foods, increases participation in food programs and provides Latino families with educational opportunities to support healthy eating, physical activity and school readiness on a limited budget.

This project will complement other work through the Statewide Health Improvement Program Grant (SHIP 4) to create a supportive nutrition and physical activity environment for Bloomington and Richfield residents. Money from the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture (USDA), Food and Nutrition Service comes to Minnesota through the Department of Human Services, which contracts with the University of Minnesota Extension (U of M Extension) to provide SNAP-Ed services. This Grant is specific to funding projects that involve U of M Extension/SNAP-Ed staff in policy, systems and environmental change.

The term of this Agreement is December 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016, with a not-to-exceed value of \$101,970.

Should the Council accept this Grant, the following adjustments to the 2016 Public Health budget will be made:
