Description

In July 2012, the City of Bloomington was awarded a federal grant in the amount of \$5.8M to reconstruct Normandale Boulevard (Hennepin County State Aid Highway 34) between Nine Mile Creek and West 94th Street. The estimated project cost is approximately \$13.2M. This safety project is a cooperative project between Hennepin County and the City, with each agency funding 50% of the remaining project costs after the federal grant (approximately \$3.7M each). There are no special assessments being considered for this project.

The federal funds for the project will be funneled thru MNDOT to the City as construction progresses. Monthly contractor pay estimates will be sent to MNDOT for reimbursement to the city. This agreement details the terms of how the funding will be handled. This agreement is similar to others the city has participated in when we are awarded federal grant funds.

The agreement has been reviewed and approved by legal.
