

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE HENNEPIN COUNTY COST PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT
FOR THE WESTBOUND RAMP TO 494 AT THE CSAH 28 (EAST BUSH LAKE ROAD)
494 INTERCHANGE (COUNTY PROJECT NO. 1412)

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bloomington is the official governing body of the City of Bloomington; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bloomington on the 2nd day of May 2016, approves the cost participation Agreement No. PW 55-07-15 with Hennepin County for the construction of the westbound ramp to I-494 at the CSAH 28 (East Bush Lake Road)/ I-494 interchange (the project); and

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington has contracted with an engineering consultant to prepare plans, specifications, and bid documents for the construction of the project: and

WHEREAS, the project is to be funded by a combination of a Federal grant (\$7,280,000), Hennepin County funds (\$8,500,000), State of Minnesota Transportation for Economic Development (TED) funds (\$8,000,000), and the City of Bloomington funds; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the project is approximately \$23,800,000 with no assessments to the public for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MINNESOTA, THAT;

1. The project improvement listed above is a project priority for Bloomington and now that the funding for the project is now complete, the City of Bloomington would like to proceed with the improvement with construction in or before the year 2017.
2. The plans and specifications for the construction of the aforementioned project will be presented to the City Council in late 2016 for approval.
3. The City Engineer shall prepare and cause to be inserted in the official paper of the City of Bloomington and in the Finance and Commerce an advertisement for bids for the making of such improvement under the approved plans and specifications. The advertisement shall be published as required by law, shall specify the work to be done, shall call the bids on the basis of cash payment for such work, shall state the date and time that the bids will be received by the City Clerk and the City Engineer at which time they will be publicly opened in the Bloomington Public Works Department and subsequently be considered by the Council; and that no bids will be considered unless sealed and filed with the City Clerk and accompanied by a cash deposit, certified check or bid bond payable to the City of Bloomington for five (5) percent of the amount of such bid.
