## What is the Comprehensive Plan?


- Sets the 20 year vision and priorities for the City

## Why update the Comprehensive Plan?

- Statutory requirement
- Regional coordination
  - THRIVE MSP 2040
- Update City goals and implementation priorities for project and policies
  - Beginning of a conversation with the public: What do we want to be?

## Comprehensive Plan Elements

- Required vs. recommended elements (see graphic – gray are recommended)



## Project Schedule

- 2016: Visioning and gathering existing conditions data
- 2017: Begin Advisory Committee meetings, revise/draft Plan Elements
- Summer 2018: Send to Metropolitan Council and surrounding communities for review
- December 2018: Final draft due to Metropolitan Council

## How can you be involved?

- Suggest groups for staff to meet with to discuss the project
- Apply for the Comprehensive Plan Advisory Committee
  - Call for applications in June/July
  - Staff will be asking for one representative from the following boards/committees:
    - Advisory Board of Health
    - City Council
    - Housing and Redevelopment Authority
    - Human Rights Commission
    - Parks, Arts and Recreation Commission
    - Planning Commission
    - Port Authority
- Encourage other Bloomington residents to apply for the Advisory Committee
- Look for staff comprehensive planning booth and participate in outreach activities at:
  - Farmers market on June 18<sup>th</sup>
  - Summer Fete, other large events
