Description

City Council is requested to approve the attached Amendment to the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) Master Grant Contract (MGC). The Amendment updates the audit language to match new Federal requirements. The original MGC was approved by City Council in December, 2014.

The MGC applies to all grants that MDH awards to community health boards (CHBs), including the City of Bloomington's Public Health Division. This document serves as the legal foundation for subsequent Grant Agreements with said CHBs for all MDH grant program funding and is intended to streamline the grant process between the State (MDH) and its grantees (i.e. the City) – thereby allowing Public Health to apply for MDH grants. Therefore, there is no funding attached to the MGC itself. However, unless the MGC is signed, Public Health cannot enter into any subsequent MDH agreements and would lose this funding.

There are several grant agreements Public Health enters into with MDH that reference this MGC. The specific value, term, duties, etc. will be set forth within each respective Grant Agreement at the time of award.

The term of the MGC remains January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2019.

This Amendment has been approved by the City Attorney's office.
