**Description**

City Council is requested to approve an Amendment to the MIECHV2 Agreement approved by City Council in 2013. MIECHV2 is the second grant agreement with the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) to expand the current Healthy Families America (HFA) program. These federal dollars fund national evidence-based home visiting models, including this program, which is targeted towards at-risk pregnant women and first-time parents.

This Amendment provides additional funds in the amount of \$7,880 to the City's Public Health Division to host up to four (4) more Growing Great Kids (GGK) trainings in Bloomington during the grant period. These funds will cover staff time, room and AV equipment rental fees, and gift cards for volunteers.

This Amendment will not require an adjustment to the 2014 Public Health Budget.

The term of the Agreement is from December 1, 2012 through March 30, 2015, with a total not-to-exceed value of \$275,260.

This Amendment has been reviewed and approved by the City Attorney's office.
