Description

The Minnesota Department of Transportation, Scott County and the Metropolitan Council initiated the Highway 169 Mobility Study in September of 2015. The study will involve the evaluation of cost effective options to improve transit service and reduce congestion along Hwy 169 corridor in the southwest metro area.

The Policy Advisory Committee (PAC) will meet quarterly until the anticipated completion of the study in the spring of 2017. Their meeting of June 30, 2016 was cancelled. Tentative next meeting will be in September 2016.

Due to the resignation of Councilmember Abrams there is vacancy on this advisory committee. Also, with the retirement of Jim Gates there is a staff opening.
