Description

The City Council is requested to consider the award of contract for the 2014-901 Storm Sewer Maintenance Project. This project includes maintenance and construction of the storm sewer system at approximately seventeen sites.

Replacement of the Mound Springs Park storm sewer outfall was originally programmed for the 2014-902 Project to be done in the winter 2014-15, but moved up due to erosion risks. The estimated costs of the work at this site, \$211,676.00, resulted in the increase over the original budget of \$470,000.00 as noted in previous Council Actions. Both the 2014-901 and 2014-902 Projects will be paid from the Storm Water Drainage Utility Budget, under Fund 530-8320-433-70-31. The extra cost of the 2014-901 will reduce the budget for the 2014-902 Project. The 2014-901 Storm Sewer Maintenance Project is done without any direct assessment to adjacent property owners.

Residents living in the vicinity of these sites will be notified of the pending construction and, if necessary, informational meetings will be held. Construction is anticipated to begin in July and be completed by November, 2014.

Bids were received and opened on Friday, June 13, at 11:00 a.m. All bids are based on unit prices and estimated quantities.

The bid results for the 2014-901 Storm Sewer Maintenance Project are as follows:

The 2014-901 Storm Sewer Maintenance Project be awarded to G.F. Jedlicki, Inc. in the amount of \$598,327.50, and approve various contract changes up to 10% of the original contract amount (\$59,832.75) for a total project construction authorization of \$658,160.25
