NATIONAL NIGHT OUT 2014

- WHEREAS, The National Association of Town Watch (NATW) is sponsoring a unique, nationwide crime and drug prevention program on August 5, 2014, called "National Night Out"; and
- WHEREAS, The "31st Annual National Night Out" provides a unique opportunity for Bloomington to join forces with thousands of other communities across the country in promoting cooperative, police-community crime and drug prevention efforts; and
