I am seeking clarification if you are formally requesting an appeal of the Hearing Examiner Decision for the variance at 10608 Alabama Circle. If an appeal of the decision is requested, the City Code Section 2.12(d) states "All parties aggrieved by the proceeding shall have the right to appeal the decision of the hearing examiner within ten days to the Planning Commission pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.98.01 of this

Code”. Therefore, any appeal will not go directly to City Council and would be pulled from that agenda and sent to the Planning Commission..

Should there be an appeal, notices of the Public Hearing would be required. Therefore, any appeal would place this item on the September 11, 2014 Planning Commission Agenda.

Please contact me to discuss any questions. Should you seek to formally appeal the hearing Examiner decision, you may do so by replying to this e-mail. Otherwise, this will continue as a Consent Agenda item to the City Council.

Again, any appeal requires the Planning Commission review pursuant to the aforementioned Code reference.
