Originator Engineering	Item <b>Interagency agreement to provide signal maintenance for Hennepin County on 24th Avenue (CSAH 1) from 494 to Old Cedar Ave.</b>

## Description

To help facilitate traffic operations around the South Loop District, and to coordinate signal operations with nearby intersections along American Boulevard, Lindau Lane and Killebrew Drive, the City maintains and operates the traffic signals along County State Aid Highway 1 (CSAH 1) for Hennepin County on a reimbursable basis. This includes signalized intersections along 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue from I-494 south to Old Shakopee Road, and signals along Old Shakopee Road from 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Old Cedar Avenue. The following 8 signals are covered under this agreement:

- CSAH 1 at East 79<sup>th</sup> Street
- CSAH 1 at American Boulevard (East 80<sup>th</sup> Street)
- CSAH 1 at Lindau Lane (East 81<sup>st</sup> Street)
- CSAH 1 at East 82<sup>nd</sup> Street
- CSAH 1 at Transit Station (8300 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue South)
- CSAH 1 at Killebrew Drive/East Old Shakopee
- CSAH 1 at East 86<sup>th</sup> Street
- CSAH 1 at Old Cedar Avenue

Under the agreement, the City receives \$1,100 per year per signal for minor maintenance work as outlined under the agreement.

The current document is a renewal of the existing agreement, which expires on December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2014. The term for the new agreement runs from January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2019.

## Requested Action

Staff recommends that Council approve Agreement PW 26-07-14 with Hennepin County for the maintenance and operation of Hennepin County signals along CSAH 1.
