**Human Rights Day
December 10, 2014**

WHEREAS, *The City of Bloomington joins our Nation in recognizing December 10, 2014 as International Human Rights Day; and*

WHEREAS, *Bloomington recognizes the importance of acknowledging the diversity that exists in our community as we strive for autonomous participation in our community affairs; and*

WHEREAS, *the devastating impact of prejudice can be eliminated through the efforts of our schools and city in promoting human rights awareness; and*
