## Description

In August of 2014, City Staff received an inquiry from the Bloomington Police Department about installing a street light along Oakland Avenue between 9349 & 9401 Oakland Avenue. The PD indicated that light is requested for public safety reasons and the residents in the area are in support of its installation.

The proposed new street light location meets the minimum spacing criteria of 300 feet from the existing light to the south but not from the existing light to the north which is only 225 feet from the proposed location. All installation work would take place within the City Right of Way.

According to our procedure, the new street light would now be installed, subject to funding. Xcel Energy will install a new 150-watt high pressure luminaire with photoelectric control and a cobra head cut-off fixture (which is called for in our standards.) There would be no up-front cost for the new light pole installation. The lighting cost would be about \$17.55 per month.

Funding for the monthly lighting cost will come from fund 101-7502-425-63-01.

## Requested Action

Staff recommends approval of the installation of the new local street light on Oakland Avenue between 9349 Oakland Avenue & 9401 Oakland Avenue.
